Materials

Yarn: 400 yds / 365 m fingering weight

yarn. Most sock yarns will work perfectly, pattern can be easily modified to adapt to yardage

available.

Needles: US 4 / 3.5 mm needles

Terminology

Abbreviation	Explanation
k	Knit
р	Purl
yo	Yarn over
ktbl	Knit through back of the loop
k2tog	Knit 2 sts at the same time
ssk	Slip first stitch as if to knit, slip second stitch as if to knit, knit two slipped stitches together.
pm	Place marker
slm	Slip marker
RS	Right side of pattern
WS	Wrong side of pattern

Pattern:

Generic row instructions:

Garter (RS): k2, yo, k until marker, yo, slm, k1,

yo, k until 2 sts remain, yo, k2

Garter (WS): k2, ktbl, k until 2 sts before marker,

ktbl, k1, slm, ktbl, k until 3 sts

remain, ktbl, k2

Mesh (RS): k2, yo, k1, *yo, k2tog* until

marker, yo, slm, k1, *yo, ssk* until

3 sts remain, yo, k1, yo, k2

Mesh (WS): k2, p until 1 st before marker, k1,

slm, p until 2 sts remain, k2

Pattern:

Cast on 3 sts.

Row 1: k1, yo, pm, k1, yo, k1 (5 sts total)

Row 2: k1, ktbl, k1, slm, ktbl, k1 (5 sts) Row 3: k2, yo, slm, k1, yo k2 (7 sts) Row 4: k2, ktbl, k1, slm, ktbl, k2 (7 sts) Rows 5-28: Work Garter (RS) for oddnumbered rows, Garter (WS) for even-numbered rows. (55 sts) Rows 29-32: Work Mesh (RS) for oddnumbered rows, Mesh (WS) for even-numbered rows. (63 sts) Rows 33-48: Work Garter RS and WS (95 sts) Rows 49-56: Work Mesh RS and WS (111 sts) Rows 57-72: Work Garter RS and WS (143 sts) Rows 73-88: Work Mesh RS and WS (175 sts) Rows 89-104: Work Garter RS and WS (207 sts) R 105-136: Work Mesh RS and WS (271 sts) *Note: if you're afraid of running* out of yarn and do not want to dip into another skein, consider proceeding to next section after an even-numbered row before finishing all mesh rows in this section. R 137-139: Work Garter RS and WS (279 sts) Row 140: Bind off: K2 sts, slip sts back to left needle, k2tog. *k1 st, slip 2 sts back to left needle, k2tog*, repeat

Finishing

Weave in ends, block shawl into shape. Moderate stretching is recommended to get the mesh and garter to open up a bit.

** until 1 st remains on right needle, cut yarn and pull through
